CYPRUS

COVID-19 Protocol & Guidelines

(updated 10 June 2021)

- All conference participants must have one of the following upon arrival:
 1. Proof of a completed COVID-19 vaccination series at least 14 days prior the conference
 2. Recent negative COVID-19 PCR test received within 72 hours
 3. Recent antigen / rapid test within 24 hours

The evidence of any of the above will not be checked by the organizers or the hotel but in case of inspection by the authorities each participant has to provide such evidence in order to avoid any fines.

- All conference participants will enter the venue through a designated entrance.
- All conference participants **must** wear a facemask at all times in all public indoor settings and outdoor settings, with exception of actively engaging in eating/drinking or while making a presentation. Anyone not adhering to the face covering policy will be asked to comply or leave.
- Body temperature control across the venue entrance. Note that normal body temperature is 35.8-36.8 Celsius. Increased body temperature is 37 Celsius and above. Participants with increased or high temperature will have to be isolated in their room according to the Cyprus Ministry of Health. The organizers may randomly check temperature at entrance.
- In the venue, all conference participants will be seated socially distanced from one another as this is indicated by the Cyprus Ministry of Health.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the venue.
- Elevators will have limited capacity that will be posted outside each entrance.
- Venue / presentation rooms will be fielded up to the capacity allowance (50%) of the Cyprus Ministry of Health.
- Staff will be strategically placed in the venues to promote and remind all conference participants and visitors of proper social distancing as well as mask adherence.
- If any participant or visitor or staff member is not feeling well, even if their symptoms are mild, they should be isolated in their room. If they do not live in the hotel and visits the conference, in case of a student, teachers or parents are responsible to take an action.
- If any participant or visitor or staff member come across an emergency risk or accident then an ambulance will be called.

Due to strict adherence to regulations, there can be no exceptions to the capacity limits, testing requirements or other guidelines and protocols shared above.

Please note that our physically organized conference plans continue to be subject to the Cyprus Ministry of Health regulations as their latest version.

When any of the above refers to a student under age 18, accompany teacher or parents are responsible.
